Restoring your Metal Surface

It is easy to get your La Bastille top looking like new. Follow these steps.

High Polish Pewter, Brass, Bronze & No Patina Finishes

To remove oxidation and address any surface that **were not** chemically treated with a patina solution by La Bastille, simply apply Brasso on a rag and use some elbow grease. Do not apply the Brasso directly on the surface as you will see steaks. Edge profiles with oxidation can best be addressed by hand with super fine, 0000 OT Steel wool, available on Amazon or any Big Box store.

Surfaces with Patina Applied

To retouch surfaces that La Bastille applied patina, use a maroon Scotch-Brite pad (3M™ Scotch-Brite™ 7447) with an orbital sander in a circular motion

over the entire surface area (both are available on Amazon or any Big Box store). This will lift the patina. Keep working through the surface until you have the finish you desire. **Do not spot treat by hand** with the Scotch Brite pads it will not blend well with the remainder of the top. If you would like the top darker, we will supply you with patina solution and instructions to apply.

Sealant

If you decide that prefer a more static finish, you can always apply a metal sealant. Once you get the finish to the desired tone by using the above steps, we recommend Smart Coat, which is VOC free, odorless and food safe. Smart coat comes in satin or matte finish and is applied in two light coats. Two hours are needed between coats.
